as Demand Continues to Grow



Per Base Cost of Providing 24 / 7 Service \$3 million/year to operate 80% fixed costs



No Surprises Act

- Health plans reimbursing at 40% costs
- 7.5 mos. delay in payment from out of network health plans
- · Continued health plan bad behavior

Impact of No Surprises Act and inflationary costs results in base closures: 75% in rural areas.



Government Under-Reimbursement

- Over 70% of transports today are either Medicare, Medicaid, or uninsured
- Reimbursement rates are 30-50% of actual costs

The role of commercial coverage has been incredibly important to maintaining access, but root issues are under-reimbursement from government payors.

COVID Impact / Labor Shortages

- Front line labor costs up 11% in 2022
- Fuel costs up 29% in 2022

- Demand Up 6% in 2022
- Overall reimbursement down 12% and decreasing



Department of Veterans Affairs Proposed Rule

- Lowers reimbursement to Medicare rates; an 80% reduction
- 90% of bases that will close are in rural America



- 25% of Veterans live in rural America.
- Veterans, particularly those in rural areas, will lose access to timely critical care as bases will close



Over 40+ bases will close, LEAVING VETERANS AND THEIR COMMUNITIES BEHIND
